WELCOME !

To make joining the Mornington Peninsula Patchworkers Inc. a little less bewildering, the following details have been compiled for your convenience. We welcome everyone from raw beginners to the very experienced.

1. M.P.P.Inc. is an affiliated group member of Victorian Quilter's Inc.
2. Gatherings are held from 10.00am - 3:00pm at The Studio, 91 Wilsons Road, Mornington on **the 2nd Monday day of the month**, regardless of whether it is a public holiday or not. Jan to Nov.
3. There is a \$20.00 joining fee and Name Badges are available at a cost of \$12.00.
4. Annual Membership is \$40.00, due on September 30th and failure to be financial by the AGM in November requires a new joining fee, loss of continuity of membership and the inability to vote at the AGM.
5. **The A.G.M. is usually held in November of each year**
6. The hall is open from 10.00am. If you wish to bring hand work and lunch (BYO mug) you are very welcome. This can be a very valuable learning and social time. The information session commences at 1pm.
7. There is also a trading table for the buying and selling of goods; the club keeps 10% commission.
8. **A \$5.00 charge is made per meeting.**
Visitors can attend two free Monday gatherings before applying for membership.
9. A raffle is held on Monday club days. Tickets are included in the entry fee.
10. Volunteers and Friendship groups are rostered each month to help with the kitchen . A co-ordinator oversees the tasks. If you cannot do your duty, please arrange to swap with another member/group or see the co-ordinator for assistance. We also have a roster for the reception desk.
11. **Our newsletter, "Patch N Times"**, is produced monthly. We encourage you to receive it in colour via email.
12. Exhibitions are held to display members work. Quilt-Ins are popular: a day dedicated to hand-sewing and fun, guest speakers & retail therapy. You are welcome to help on these sub-committees.
13. There is a **Library** which operates each Monday gathering and members are allowed to borrow books between 1 to 3 months. A library-Membership card will be issued in your new members pack.
14. **Friendship groups** are held in member's homes. Groups are available in most areas. The co-ordinator
(See newsletter) will be happy to assist those looking for a suitable group. Or simply start your own !!
15. **Textiles Group (MTAG)**. The textiles group meets once a month to encourage self-development, creative inspiration and a platform for all members to move forward as individuals enhancing their creative talents. Meets on the 3rd Saturday of the month (Jan-Nov) from 10am to 3pm. **Cost is \$5.00 plus materials.**
